

RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT
THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA
ON THE 14TH DAY OF April, 2009

WHEREAS, Community mental health and substance abuse services are imperative for the wellbeing of our community; and

WHEREAS, Seminole Behavioral Healthcare provides comprehensive, biopsychosocial rehabilitation programming in the areas of mental health; and

WHEREAS, The Seminole County Commission supports the continued funding of \$16,200,000 in "special projects" statewide; and

WHEREAS, included in this amount is \$400,000 appropriated to Seminole Behavioral Healthcare nine years ago which enabled the expansion of the Crisis Stabilization Unit by seven beds; and

WHEREAS, in the ensuing years growing demand for the current 21 beds has necessitated plans by Seminole Behavioral Healthcare for an expansion of the unit to 30 beds; and

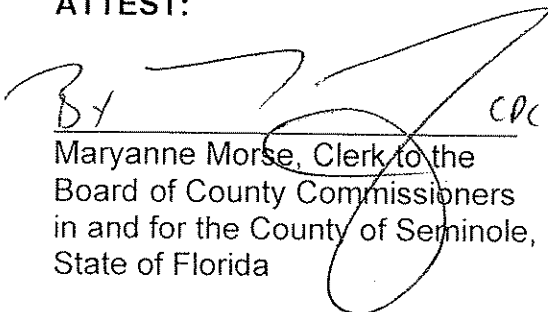
WHEREAS, a loss of \$400,000 would cause the closure of seven beds at a time when more, not fewer, beds are needed for our community; and

WHEREAS, actions are necessary to preserve the \$16,200,000 and allow Seminole Behavioral Healthcare to maintain, and enhance, its Crisis Stabilization capacity.

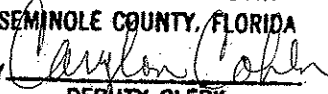
